
### Livability22202 Priorities

- Extend the Multimodal Transportation Network
- Provide Essential Services to the Community
- Encourage Engagement, Arts,
   & Culture



#### Livability22202 Connectivity Map

- Livability22202 Workshops (2019-2020) emphasized need for better neighborhood connectivity
  - Initiate and sustain community
  - Reduce vehicle reliance
  - Increase pedestrian safety
  - Better connection with nature
- Connectivity among open spaces, residences, community facilities, transit nodes, and retail
- Create connectivity with biophilic characteristics
  - Extend a park-like feel along the connections
  - Not always aligned with the street grid
  - Increase opportunities for engagement with nature
  - Consider ecological characteristics as well



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
#### AGENDA ITEM 3: COMMUNITY CONCERNS: KEY SURVEY & WORKSHOP TAKEAWAYS

- Community survey showed significant preference for crossing at underpasses
- Survey concerns with:
  - Safety of the current at-grade cross-section
  - Potential traffic diversions to parallel streets
- Community survey priorities showed:
  - Pedestrian travel across US 1 as most important, with auto travel across US 1 next
- 18th St underpass provides a safe and convenient connection for all modes: walking, biking, transit riding, and driving
  - In survey 18<sup>th</sup> St was favored by a 12:1 ratio (favored vs avoided)
  - 38% of respondents cross US 1 at 18<sup>th</sup> St

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### AGENDA ITEM 3: COMMUNITY CONCERNS: KEY SURVEY & WORKSHOP TAKEAWAYS

- Safe and convenient east-west connections are priority
- 23rd St perceived as risky by pedestrians and cyclists
  - Survey showed 23<sup>rd</sup> St as overwhelmingly identified as dangerous
  - Other responses suggested it was confusing and congested
  - Avoided by a 2:1 ratio
- Traffic queuing issues at 23rd St S
  - Short block complicates options
  - Absence of dedicated signal phases for turning movements
- Ambivalence about current 15th or 20th St S crossings and proposed changes


